However, WW players planning to gain additional skills on a 2<sup>nd</sup> WW, might choose to take that area first. 358 must be taken concurrently with each tech course (350-355).

<sup>c</sup>These courses which appear in the same semester must be taken concurrently. You must be admitted into the teacher education program before you can sign up for Music 480K.

**Flexibility in scheduling:** Many **general education** and **education** courses can easily be taken in different semesters than indicated as well as in the summer. Music courses are best kept in the order/semesters indicated. (Most music courses are offered one semester each year.)
